
Cauliflower Ear Grand Prix

Rickson Gracie, the living legend of Mixed Martial Arts, has a undefeated record. The Cauliflower Grand Prix may be his first loss.








Wild Billy Childish: Heavens


There is no mercy on the streets. If you can't escape an attacker you are left with only one option – defend your life with everything you've got. There is no such thing as "taking it easy" when it comes to protecting your life or the lives of your loved ones. But what do you do when you are confronted with a vicious attack from the fairer sex and you are a gentleman? How do you defend yourself against the attacker you have sworn to never hit?

When confronted with a female attacker, here is some advice for boys and even girls who don't want to physically hurt their assailants. This article is not about copping free feelies or taking sexual advantage of your attacker it is about self-defense so please bear with the explicit details.

The Big Hug. Embrace the attacker with both arms and say "I don't want to hurt you. I love you. I. Love. You." Repeating the words in a calm manner might help break their raging urge to kill you. The hug could be stomach to back or face to face but stay away from her teeth unless you want to lose your nose. Hold her close in a manner to protect your groin from knee strikes. Never use these techniques for evil only in self-defense when you cannot run away. If you use these moves improperly you may only cause yourself injury and even death. $\not\approx$






Band of Ninja

DM: I'm sure you get asked this all the time but when you travel, instead of taking cars do you run on top of the grass?

Outdo: We don't even run dude, we float.

Indo: We just appear.

DM: Do you guys ever switch your instruments just to see if people are paying attention?

Outdo: We do whole shows where I play bass and he plays drums.

DM: And you are?


Gongis Khan: Gongis Khan

Outdo: Usually it is (minimized). But we have our guest ninjas just to change it up. It's cool to have flavors like you said. Guitar or vocals...


Indo: Another bass sometimes.

DM: Any closing remarks?


