SUBJECT: "1973 Ocotlan Visitation Program" Activities

The following information may be of interest to members of the City Council who are planning to participate in the Sister City Visitation Program activities scheduled for Saturday afternoon and Monday evening.

Plaque Dedication Ceremony - Saturday, July 28, 1:00 P.M.


The purpose of this ceremony will be to unveil the plaque which has been prepared to indicate that the Colonia-Third Street Overpass is being dedicated in honor of the people of Ocotlan (a separate ceremony dedicating the facility itself will be held upon the completion of the overpass in September; that ceremony will be widely publicized and involve local community groups). The ceremony on Saturday will be conducted at the north end of the "A" Street Mall at Third Street. It will consist of a brief welcome by Mayor Tolmach, a few dedication remarks by Councilman Sanchez (the City Council's designated Sister City Program representative), the unveiling of the plaque, and some responding remarks by Ocotlan's Mayor Antonio Salcedo or his representative. Following this brief ceremony, those in attendance will be invited to the home of Mr. Rudy Palazuelos, Chairman of Oxnard's Sister City Committee, for a champagne reception. Mr. Palazuelos' home is located at 350 Glenwood Drive.

Recognition Night Dinner - Monday, July 30, 7:30 P.M.

The dinner program has been planned by the Oxnard Sister City Committee; the City will be supporting the program by purchasing the dinners of the guests from Ocotlan as previously approved by the City Council. This program, which will be held

in the Ventura Room at the Community Center, will begin at 7:30 P.M. with a no-host cocktail hour; dinner will follow at 8:30 P.M. in the same room. The Sister City Committee has made arrangements for a musical entertainment program following the dinner. During Monday evening's program, Mayor Tolmach will be joining with Mr. Palazuelos in jointly presenting certificates to each of the guests from Ocotlan commemorating their participation in the 1973 Visitation Program. Members of the City Council in attendance will also be asked to make presentations to the Mayor of Ocotlan and to the Chairman of Ocotlan's Sister City Committee; these presentations will consist of specially prepared plaques and a formal letter to members of Ocotlan's Sister City Committee.
