CAMARILLO STATE HOSPITAL

The following fact sheet has been compiled to provide a general introduction to the hospital's programs, facilities and staffing in the areas of treatment, training and research.

Camarillo State Hospital, California's largest psychiatric center, is located in a picturesque foothill setting near the City of Camarillo, Ventura County, California. The hospital is the administrative seat of the South Coast Service Area which includes the counties of Ventura, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, a portion of Kern County, and about sixty percent of Los Angeles County.

TREATMENT

Providing a general psychiatric treatment program, the hospital is also equipt and staffed to render a complete medical and surgical service to meet needs as they arise within the patient group. Camarillo State Hospital is also the site of one of two Department of Mental Hygiene treatment facilities for children in California. The hospital is recognized nationally for pioneering work in a number of clinical fields and in 1963 was awarded the Bronze Service Achievement Award of the American Psychiatric Association. Camarillo State Hospital is fully accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals.

TRAINING

Camarillo State Hospital is deeply involved in training at all levels. There are presently 23 physicians engaged in the hospital's psychiatric residency program. In addition to university and college affiliations, over 2000 people visit the hospital each year for educational purposes. Nationally prominent figures frequently visit the hospital as training consultants to participate in various programs.

RESEARCH

Education

The hospital's research program is directed toward a wide variety of basic and applied subjects, both funded and non-funded. Funded projects are financed by federal, state or private grants. In addition to the work done by the nucleus of research personnel and project staffs, all professional staff members are encouraged to become involved in some form of research, with consultation provided by this department. During an eighteen-month period, over sixty papers by staff members of Camarillo State Hospital were published in professional journals. The hospital publishes its own journal each quarter.
