FACULTY INFORMATION BULLETIN  
30 May 1979

1. FINAL EXAMINATIONS. Faculty members are reminded of the provisions of Section 203.5 of the College Handbook which states:

Each non-seminar, five-quarter unit course shall include an appropriate instrument for comprehensive evaluation of student performance. If a written final examination is to serve as that instrument, the examination shall be given only during the regularly scheduled final examination period.

Both internal and external complaints indicate that some faculty are shifting times of scheduled examinations or are moving final examinations to the last day of class. It would seem that the latter practice defeats the requirement that five-quarter unit courses include an "appropriate" instrument for comprehensive evaluation of student performance" and shortens the class schedule in the process.
