Designed to educate young people about agriculture, the new exhibit was a joint project of the Jordan College of Agricultural Sciences and Technology, Fresno Chaffee Zoo, Gar and Esther Tootelian Charitable Foundation, Bennett & Bennett Irrigation and the Fresno County Farm Bureau.

The former Small Wonders petting zoo has been transformed into the Valley Farm exhibit. Guests now have the opportunity to pet and interact with sheep, goats, chickens, a dairy cow and other farm animals.
