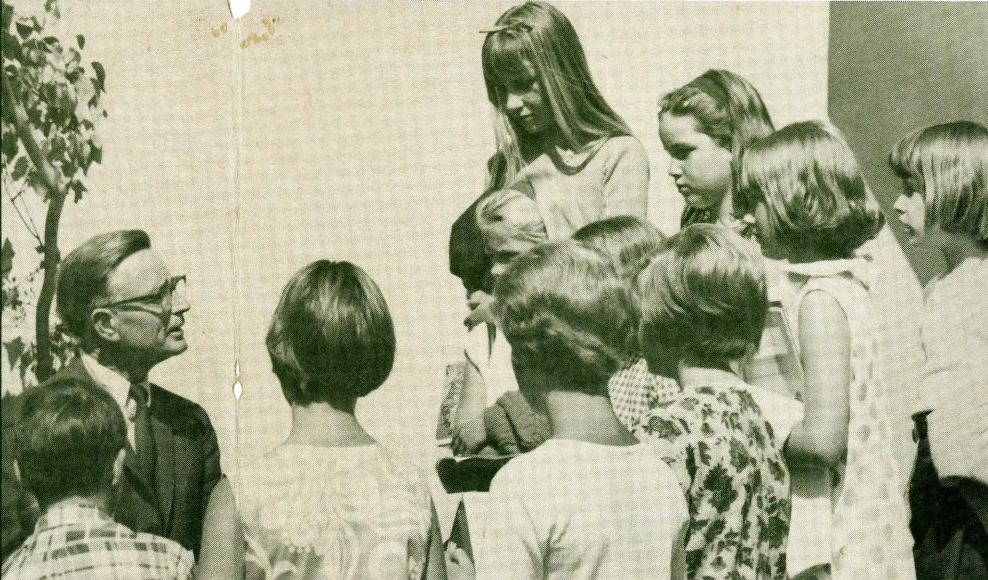

One month after the assassination Congress authorized the Kennedy half-dollar. Only six Congressmen out of 435 voted NO; incumbent Teague and five others.

Teague's NO vote typifies his record. The record tells the story of a man and Teague has asked that he be judged by it. Only Teague and two others voted NO to libraries in medical and dental schools. Only Teague and seven others voted NO to Contempt of Congress charges against Bernard Goldfine, when during questioning about improper influence involving government officials, he refused to reveal what had happened to three-quarters of a million dollars in cashier's checks. And so the record goes.

Again and again incumbent Teague voted with a small group of negative men, out of step with our times, deaf to the needs of people now, and blind to the demands of the future. Incumbent Teague has voted:

NO to Old Age Assistance; Aid to the Blind and Disabled.

NO to Fair Labor Standards for Children.

NO to Brucellosis Control on School Milk.

NO to Federal programs which help our cities and counties keep down property taxes.

NO to Air and Water Pollution Control.

NO to Aid to Airports, Sewage Disposal, Urban Renewal.

NO to Education, to Manpower Retraining, to the War on Poverty.

The 12-year long list of NOs is almost unbelievable. It has been hidden behind a pose of moderation in his Washington Report, which Teague mails to voters at taxpayers expense.

By Congressional courtesy the incumbent is permitted to announce (and get credit for) projects for his district although he may have voted NO on the project, as Teague so often does.

Only four bills, authored by Teague were enacted during the 12 years he served in Congress. One permitted transfer of certain U.S. property to Oxnard Harbor District. Another allowed increased compensation for certain war hazards. The third provided for payment of certain amounts to offset certain expenses of federal employes traveling to duty on certain off-shore California islands. The last provides duty-free importation of certain wild animals, fishes and birds. This is the full and complete legislative accomplishment of the incumbent. It is Teague's record. He has asked that we judge him by it.
