

PREVETERINARY

Students preparing for the veterinary profession can satisfy their preveterinary curriculum requirements at CSUF. Preveterinary students should plan to complete a BS Degree prior to application to a school of veterinary medicine. Recommended preveterinary courses are Animal Science 10, 120, and 125; Botany 10; Chemistry 1A, 1B, 8, 109 and 150; Physiology 140; Physics 1A and 1B; Microbiology 20 and 21; Zoology 1 and 160. The School of Agriculture and Home Economics is equipped to provide valuable experience with large animals through the student project program. Students desiring further information regarding the preveterinary curriculum should consult the Chairman of the Animal Science Department.
