

Theodore J. "Ted" Moniz was named County Agricultural Commissioner by County Executive Howard W. Campen.

A veteran of thirty-three years in the Commissioner's office, the 56-year old Moniz was Assistant Agricultural Commissioner for eight years under David T. Rayner. Upon Rayner's retirement two months ago, Moniz became Acting Commissioner.

Moniz joined the Commissioner's staff in 1931

as a Clerk and in 1932 was made an Inspector. He became a Deputy Commissioner in 1946, and Assistant Commissioner in 1955.

The Agricultural Commissioner is the County's chief agricultural official, with an annual top salary of \$12, 288. He is charged with enforcing the bulky State agricultural code and County agricultural ordinances. He also directs an advisory service to agriculturists and compiles statistics on crops, income, etc.

The importance of agriculture locally is shown by the fact that it still retains its traditional standing as the County's No. 1 source of income. Last year County agricultural income was \$72,098,630.

Moniz lives at 1074 Camino Pablo in Willow Glen. He is married, has one married daughter and a grandchild.

A native of nearby Niles, the new Commissioner attended Oakgrove Grammar School, seven miles south of San Jose, and St. Joseph's High School in San Jose. He also attended business college in San
