Dear Boy

I've just finished writing a short letter to Soltie and to Broken me back. Today it rained all day. Mother is better - she dresses herself and walks about on this floor very smart. The nurse is here yet - but she expects to change her next week. Emma - Arvey and Dudu are well but they don't look real well. I don't know why - they certainly have everything on earth to eat and comfortable beds and clothes and nothing to do but play, everything is done for them. Parn is not well and I don't know what is the matter with him, unless it's biliousness, he looks puffy faced. he rides his

reloufede. and goes to school - her
coughs a good deal. it may be that
his hair is too long - I've given him
a blue pill and some shubarb - tomorrow
I shall get some Caliseya bark for him
and have his hair cut. if that don't
improve his appearance I shall
send for a Doctor; he is as singular
child any way - Arue is very lively and
sharp - he wanted Tudu's finger rings
yesterday before breakfast, and because he
could not have them - he danced up
and down in his crib screamed and
beat his head and got into such a
tempest that he fairly trembled all
over - and consequently was sick all
the rest of the day - but slept until
twenty minutes of eight this morning -
Emma sends you her love and says
she is "so good" and helps Sarah as
much - and is always willing to help any

one" - tonight she said she "would not eat the bone of her apple" - She went home with India to dinner one day last week and Uncle Sam took her and Jeanie to the Park to feed the deer. Yesterday she and Dudu spent the day with the Salimons and had a grand time, they gave them two nice books and a lot of pictures to cut out. Two of the young ladies came for them, and two brought them back -
