At your request we are reserving accommodations for you for the National Convention in Los Angeles as set forth in the attached form.

Please read the directions, complete the form and return it to us IMMEDIATELY with your check for \$50.00 covering deposit for five days occupancy in one of the official hotels or motels. If we do not hear from you by MONDAY, JUNE 27, we will assume that you do not wish us to hold space for you. We will contact you at the earliest possible moment to let you know where your reservation has been made.

Delegation Headquarters will be in the Hollywood Knickerbocker Hotel. Because of the space requirements of our large delegation, members will be housed there and in nearby motels. In many cases the motel accommodations are superior to those in the hotel and plans are to dispatch a shuttle bus from the Hollywood Knickerbocker to bring those housed in the motels to and from the headquarters, on call.

We have inserted a space on the form so that you may indicate your preference as to hotel or motel. We will try in every way possible to give you what you want, but space limitations will not always permit our doing so. If you indicate that your preference is for hotel accommodations it would be helpful if you would arrange to share a room with some other member of the delegation.

You are urged to arrive in Los Angeles on Saturday, July 9th. At that time you may pick up your credentials at the Delegation Headquarters in the Knickerbocker Hotel. Chairman Clair Engle has invited members of the delegation to cocktails in the Hollywood Room of the Knickerbocker that evening and there will be a brunch on Sunday. Also on Sunday the first delegation caucus will be held in the Hollywood Room at 2 p.m.
