- 4) **McDonald** reported on WASC.AAHC Conference
The main focus was on “What does an SSU graduate look like?” Issues discussed were: creating a university learning community; assessment of graduates’ outcomes; resources for developing assessment measures
- 5) **Warmoth** reported on attending American Assn of Colleges and Universities.
Focus: “What is the mission of a liberal arts university?” Issues discussed were: resources for assessment; assessment; diversity; outcomes measures. **Coleman** added that issues of diversity, assessments, resources are paramount
- 6) **McDonald** distributed questions for self-study of Senate. She will represent EPC in the process. Input from all EPC members encouraged. Issues to be addressed are: liaison to committees; tenure of chair; reporting back to schools, departments and faculty
- 7) Program Review Protocol – **Carlos Benito** read a letter that discussed the need to have appropriate resources to support program review.
