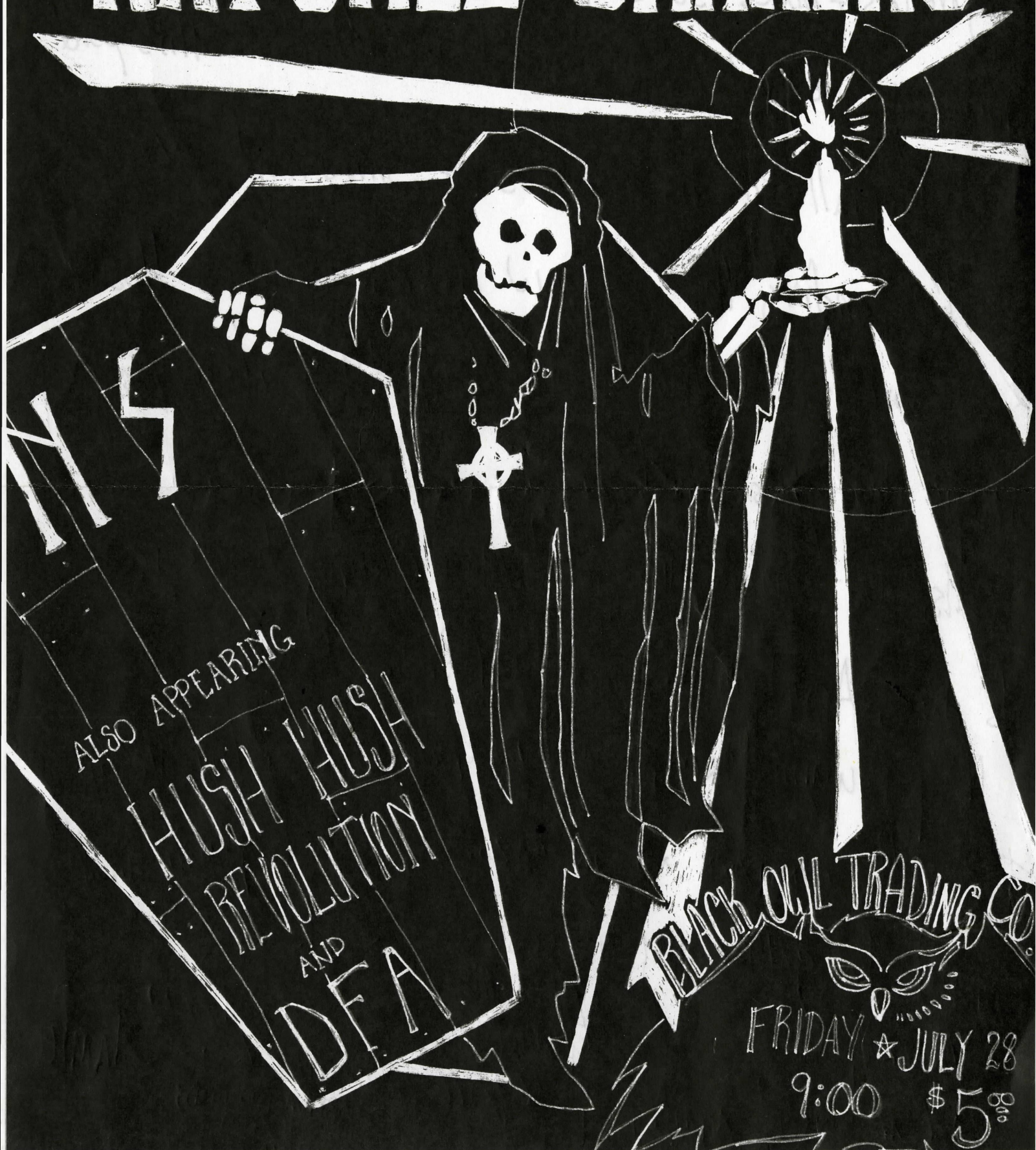


BACK FROM THE GRAVE, FOR ONE NIGHT ONLY, HERE ARE

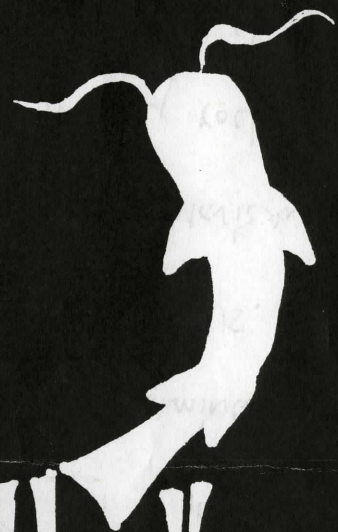
