ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Title XII, Article I of the "General Nonprofit Corporation Law" of the State of California,

And we hereby certify:

ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be San Luis Obispo Buddhist Church.

ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To cultivate and promote the social, educational and religious welfare of the members.

2. To lease, purchase, hold, have and use, take possession of, and enjoy in fee simple or otherwise, any personal or real property necessary for the uses and purposes of the corporation, and to sell, lease, mortgage, deed in trust, alien or dispose of the same, at the pleasure of the corporation, and for the uses and purposes for which said corporation is formed, and to buy and sell real or personal property, and to apply the proceeds of sale, including any and all income, to the uses and purposes of the corporation.

3. To own, conduct, operate, manage and control schools, places of worship, club houses, playgrounds, libraries, hospitals, sanatoriums, orphan asylums, homes for the aged, and other social, religious and philanthropic enterprises.

4. To establish, maintain and operate a cemetery, and to subdivide, lay out, dedicate, improve, repair and preserve the grounds, avenues, walks, buildings and superstructures of said cemetery, including mausoleums, and to provide perpetual care and maintenance of graves, grounds, walks, roads and buildings of every kind, and to prepare, file and record maps or plats, and

1 do any and all things provided by law for cemetary corporations.

2 5. To do any and all things which may be lawfully done in
3 carrying out the purposes of this corporation.

4 6. This corporation is onw which does not contemplate pecuniary
5 gain or profit to the members thereof.

6 ARTICLE III.

7 That the existence of this corporation is to be perpetual.

8 ARTICLE IV.

9 That the county in the State of California where the principal
10 office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is
11 to be located is San Luis Obispo County.

12 ARTICLE V.

13 That the names and addresses of the persons who are to act
14 in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors
15 are as follows:

23 That the number of persons named above shall constitute the
24 number of directors of the corporation, until changed by an amend-
25 ment to the by-laws increasing or decreasing the number of directors

27 ARTICLE VI.

28 That the authorized number and qualifications of members of
29 this corporation, the different classes of membership, if any,
30 the property, voting and other rights and privileges of each class
31 of membership, and the liability of each or all classes to dues
32 or assessments, and the method of collection thereof shall be set

10 the duly elected and acting secretary of said unincorporated
11 association; that on November 26th, 1938, at a regular meeting
12 of the members of said San Luis Obispo Buddhist Church, the in-
13 corporation of said unincorporated association was authorized
14 and directed, the directors mentioned in the annexed Articles of
15 Incorporation were duly selected, the president and secretary of
16 said unincorporated association were authorized and directed to
17 execute and sign the said Articles of Incorporation, and that
18 said president and secretary have executed said Articles of Incor-
19 poration by authority of said unincorporated association.
