## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Title XII, Article I of the "General Nonprofit Corporation Law" of the State of California, And we hereby certify:

### ARTICLE I.

That the name of the corporation shall be San Luis Obispo Buddhist Church.

### ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To cultivate and promote the social, educational and religious welfare of the members.
- 2. To lease, purchase, hold, have and use, take possession of, and enjoy in fee simple or otherwise, any personal or real property necessary for the uses and purposes of the corporation, and to sell, lease, mortgage, deed in trust, alien or dispose of the same, at the pleasure of the corporation, and for the uses and purposes for whoch said corporation is formed, and to buy and sell real or personal property, and to apply the proceeds of sale, including any and all income, to the uses and purposes of the corporation.
- 3. To own, conduct, operate, manage and control schools, places of worship, club houses, playgorunds, libraries, hospitals, sanatoriums, orphan asylums, homes for the aged, and other social, religious and philanthropic enterptises.
- 4. To establish, maintain and operate a cemetary, and to subdivide, lay out, dedicate, improve, repair and preserve the grounds, avenues, walks, buildings and superstructures of said cemetary, including mausoleums, and to provide perpetual care and maintenance of graves, grounds, walks, roads and buildings of every kind, and to prepare, file and record maps or plats, and

do any and all things provided by law for cenetary corporations. 5. To do any and all things which may be lawfully done in 2 carrying out the purposes of this corporation. 3 6. This corporation is one which does not contemplate pecuniary 4 gain or profit to the members thereof. 5 ARTICLE III. 6 That the existence of this corporation is to be perpetual. 7 ARTICLE IV. 8 That the county in the State of California where the principal 9 office for the transaction of the business of the corporation is 10 to be located is San Luis Obispo County. 11 ARTICLE V. 12 That the names and addresses of the persons who are to act 13 in the capacity of directors until the selection of their successors 14 ere as follows: 15 T. Fukunaga residing at Cambria, California 16 M. Eto San Luis Obispo, California residing at 17 H. Taku Pismo Beach, California residing at 18 San Luis Obispo, California Tom Nakaji residing at 19 I.Hori Pismo Beach, California residing at 2.0 S. Kawaoka residing at Arroyo Grande, California 21 K. That the authorized number and qualifications of members of this corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of each class of membership, and the liability of each or all classes to dues or assessments, and the method of collection thereof shall be set
