



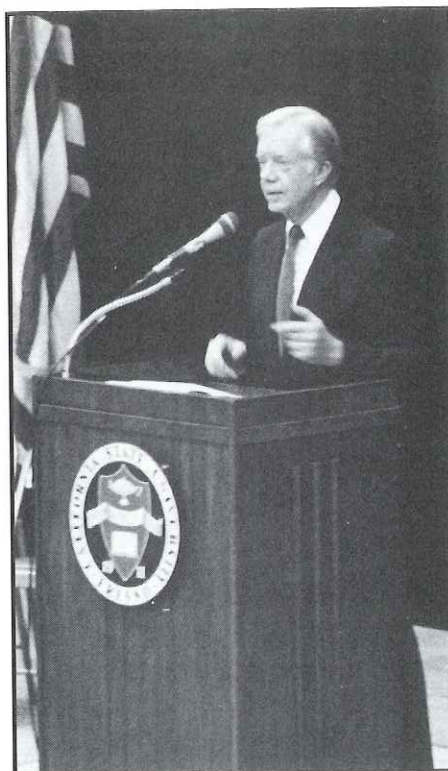
Gwendolyn Brooks

President Jimmy Carter

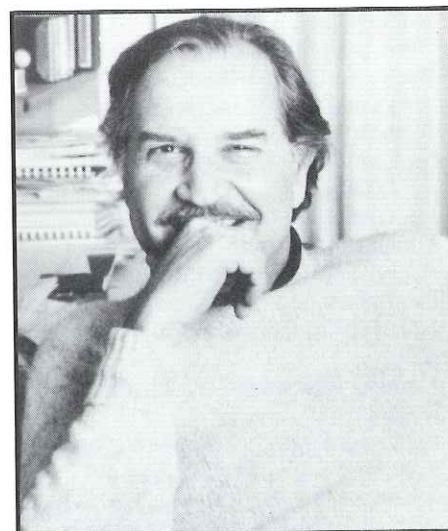
As the 39th President of the United States, Jimmy Carter's most significant achievements were the signing of the Camp David accords and his concern for human rights around the world.
