

foreign high school must have preparation equivalent to that required of eligible California high school graduates. The college will carefully review the previous record of all such applicants and only those with promise of academic success equivalent to that of eligible California high school graduates will be admitted. Such applicants may be required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or SAT and other tests deemed appropriate by the college.

**Non-High School Graduates:** An applicant who is over 21 years of age, but has not graduated from high school will be considered for admission only when his preparation in all other ways is such that the college believes his promise of academic success is equivalent to that of eligible California high school graduates.

**High School Students:** A limited number of students of exceptional ability who are enrolled in high school will be considered for admission to certain special programs if recommended by the principal and their preparation is equivalent to that required of eligible California high school graduates. Eligibility for admission is determined by the Admissions Office and is only for a given program. It does not constitute the right to continued enrollment.

**ELIGIBILITY INDEX**

The following chart is used in determining the eligibility of graduates of California high schools (or California legal residents) for freshman admission to a state university or college. Grade-point averages are based on work completed in the last three years of high school, exclusive of physical education and military science. Scores shown are the SAT total and the ACT composite. Students with a given GPA must present the corresponding test score. Conversely, students with a given ACT or SAT score must present the corresponding GPA in order to be eligible.

The minimum eligibility index is SAT, 3072 and ACT, 741. The index is computed either by multiplying the grade-point average by 800 and adding it to the total SAT score, or multiplying the grade-point average by 200 and adding it to 10 times the composite ACT score.
