We have been doing war work from the first. We began by filling "comfort-bags" for the soldier boys, and devoted one day a week to Red Cross work. In the Country Fair our class had the County Store, and combined with the Post Office, which was run by the Sr. A4's, we realized \$95 for Belgian Relief and Red Cross work. At Christmas time we helped fill candy boxes for the Normal men in service, and each member of our class sold at least twenty Red Cross stamps. Before Easter vacation, all of our Armenian and Syrian fund, which was a 50 cents a member assessment, was paid.
