Battle of the Majors Strategies and Rules Guide

Captains:	All Captains are required to attend the Team Captain meeting prior to the event and are responsible for recruiting other students for their particular major to participate in the scheduled events. They are required to set an example and create team spirit and pride to make Battle of the Majors the best it can be.
Captain's Meetings:	Captains along with one of the chair members will meet before the event to go over the rules, point system, and other details of the events.
Advertising:	There is no advertising for each individual major.
Overall Mandatory Rules:	<i>Must apply good sportsmanship!!</i> Points will be deducted for unsportsmanlike behavior determined by judges, chairs of Battle of the Majors, and our official judges. Two points will be deducted for minor infractions of unsportsmanlike behavior, and 10 points will be deducted for major infractions of unsportsmanlike behavior. Personal attacks and arguing with judges or chairs will count as unsportsmanlike behavior and points will be deducted according to the judge's discretion.
	All participants must be present prior to the event to participate.
Waivers and Liability:	Some events will require each participant to sign a waiver form. Failure to do so will result in removal of team.

KICKOFF CEREMONY

TIME:	4:00 p.m.
LOCATION:	THE HUB
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:	ALL MAJOR CAPTAINS AND PARTICPANTS; ENTIRE SCHOOL INVITED

Biology majors will return the trophy to the host of events to begin the games. There is an introduction of the captains of the majors and an overview of the events for the week.

MECHANICAL BULL

TIME:	4:30-5:30 p.m.
LOCATION:	THE HUB
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:	TO BE DETERMINED AT THE EVENT DEPENDING ON THE NUMBER OF PARTICPANTS, BUT NO MORE THAN 3 PEOPLE CAN PARTICPATE FOR EACH MAJOR.

1. A waiver must be signed to participate.
2. This is judged on the longest time someone is on the bull.
3. The best time for each major will be submitted as the final time to determine where the major ranks.
4. If time on bull reaches 5 minutes time will be stopped. If two or more majors reach the 5 minute mark a tie breaker will be performed. Rules of tie breaker will be decided by judges.
5. Anyone who wants to participate MUST participate.
6. Only one participant on the bull at a time.
7. Remove shoes, glasses, jewelry etc. before getting on the bull.
8. No food, beverages, or gum permitted while riding the bull.
9. No gloves are allowed.
10. One hand must be used to hold on to the bull, the other hand must be in the air the entire time, if the hand in the air touches the bull time will be stopped.
11. Once a body part hits the floor, time will be stopped.
12. Participant must be in good physical condition to participate. Persons with back, neck, knee or joint injury, respiratory problems or who may be pregnant should not participate. If you are currently under medical care, please consult your physician before participating on this event.
Participants must sign a waiver form.

BATTLE OF THE MAJORS EVENTS

TUESDAY

BIG RELAY

TIME: 11:15-11:40 a.m.

LOCATION: THE HUB

NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS: 7-13 PEOPLE

1. A waiver must be signed to participate.
2. Each major's team will be given a banana at the beginning of the relay. The banana will be passed from participant to participant throughout the relay like a baton. If the banana is dropped at any time the participant who dropped it must pick it up and go back to the beginning of their section of the relay. The banana can be held, placed in the mouth, under the chin, under the armpit etc. as long as it is not dropped.
3. 3-legged race (2 people)
 - a. Must stay attached at the leg
 - b. If a player falls, they must start over and continue until they finish
4. Wheelbarrel race (can be same 2 people-depending on number of participants)
 - a. Must hold onto the other person's feet at all times
 - b. Knees and feet cannot touch the ground, if they do, team must start over and continue until they finish
5. Leap Frog (can be same 2 people-depending on number of participants)
 - a. Whole entire body must jump over the other body.
 - b. No half or partial jumps
6. Balloon Hurdle (1 person)
 - a. Participant will blow up two balloons and then push the two balloons, without using their hands, to a certain marked place.
 - b. If balloon breaks participant needs to start over and get another balloon that is provided.
7. Fill the Bottle (1 person-can be same person depending on number of participants)
 - a. Participant will fill sponge with water and squeeze it into a bottle until the amount of water passes marked line.
 - b. Once bottle is filled to line participant can progress on.
8. Cotton Ball Relay (1 person-can be same person depending on number of participants)
 - a. Participant will use a spoon to scoop out a cotton ball from a bowl.
 - b. Participant will then balance cotton ball on spoon all the way to marked line.
 - c. If cotton ball drops, participant must scoop it up without using their hands and continue to finish line.
9. Pass the Orange (3 people)
 - a. Team will be given an orange which the first person should tuck under their chin. The orange should be passed to the person behind them along with the banana. When the orange gets to the third person, they come to the front and start again.
 - b. If the orange is dropped team must pick up orange and continue with relay, however if team drops banana, they must start over.

10. Crab Walk (1 person)
 - a. Participant must walk on all fours with their belly in the air.
 - b. If bottom touches the ground or banana drops to the ground, participant must start over.
11. Pyramid (everyone who participated in the event)
 - a. Must construct a pyramid in a strategic manner.
 - b. No dogpiles.
 - c. Not allowed to begin construction until after the person before finishes their crab walk.
12. 15 points for 1st
 10 points for 2nd
 5 points for 3rd
 2 points for participation
 1 point for banana in best shape
 1 point for most creative pyramid

FACULTY/STAFF RELAY

TIME:	11:15-11:40 a.m.
LOCATION:	THE HUB
NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:	1 faculty or staff member for each major

1. A waiver must be signed by participant.
2. Each faculty or staff member will be given a banana at the beginning of the relay. The banana must be held the entire relay. If the banana is dropped at any time the faculty or staff member must pick it up and go back to the beginning of that section of the relay. The banana can be held, placed in the mouth, under the chin, under the armpit etc. as long as it is not dropped.
3. Batspin blindfolded 10 seconds
 - a. Whistle will begin and end this period of the relay.
4. Book Balance
 - a. Faculty/staff member must balance a book on their head to a marked place, if dropped they must start over.
5. Hula Hoop
 - a. Must complete 10 rotations of the hoop, if dropped start over.
 - b. Must count out the rotations out loud.
6. Balloon Hurdle
 - a. Faculty/staff member will blow up two balloons and then push the two balloons, without using their hands, to a certain marked place.
 - b. If balloon breaks participant needs to start over and get another balloon that is provided.
7. Ice Fishing
 - a. Faculty/staff member must find a marble in a bucket of ice.
 - b. Cannot continue until they finish.
8. Skip
 - a. Faculty/staff member must skip to the finish line and yell out their major.
9. 15 points for 1st
 10 points for 2nd
 5 points for 3rd
 2 points for participation
 1 point for banana in best shape
