Criminals should be rehabilitated; not perpetuated and hardened by fear, cruelty, torture and hate. Aren't you proud that in our State of California things are different? However, sad to say, California isn't too much different. The difference is that here in California we are more sophisticated in the way we murder and dispose of the victim. So that there will be no misunderstanding, I am going to offer a verified and duly legal affidavit: (I will notarise it if desired)

AFFIDAVIT, County of Santa Cruz. I. N K Fields, being of sound mind and of normal perception, with any

4. It is not true that just because you have clean record and a good background that you are sure to get probation.

One final word: If you don't like the law, work to change it, don't violate it! The age of martyrs ended several centuries ago that scene is no longer cool.

Perhaps my way is no better, but at least I'm not fooling myself or anyone else into thinking that I am accurately quoting the text of


Mr. Gregory's speech.


NEEDED: A GOOD HEAD
