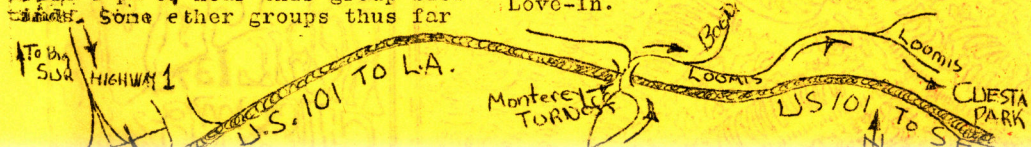

PRIME "ATASCADERO" STATE HOSPITAL PART 2

FIRST PUBLISHED IN "OUR DAILY STRUGGLE" BY N. K. FIELDS

The recent news of brutal murders in Arkansas is no surprise to many of us. Some of us know of atrocity which our politicians keep well hidden. The most revealing and most sinister aspect of this atrocity is the administration's attempt to cover up crime and to impede prison reform. Why would politicians want to stop Professor Morton's good work? Any honest public official would not be afraid of an investigation. The headless corpse could very well lead to other skeletons in other closets - but we must search where the authorities are afraid to look. When we get down to cases, most politicians, most especially judges and D As, have their secrets and many would not hesitate to have a man imprisoned and killed in order to preserve those secrets.

Is it not strange that in our "enlightened" times we should subject our criminals, and sometimes innocent human beings, to such degrading and sadistic influences as a criminally influenced political penal system? Criminals should be rehabilitated; not perpetuated and hardened by fear, cruelty, torture and hate. Aren't you proud that in our State of California things are different? However, sad to say, California isn't too much different. The difference is that here in California we are more sophisticated in the way we murder and dispose of the victim. So that there will be no misunderstanding, I am going to offer a verified and duly legal affidavit: (I will notarise it if desired)

AFFIDAVIT, County of Santa Cruz. I, N K Fields, being of sound mind and of normal perception, with any and all allegations to the contrary unproven, declare and affirm that in or about December 1964 while I was unjustly and illegally imprisoned in the Atascadero State Hospital at Atascadero, California, not as a patient; but as a political prisoner, I did personally witness the cruel and painful murder of two (2) men, to wit: a one Benjamin Durazo from Picoima, California, and a one Harold Satcher from Los Angeles, California, and also being drugged to death. It took two attempted murder and ruination of

others, by a one Doctor Harry A. Nevel with the full knowledge and complicity of Dr. Lee Sanadritter, et al., by and through the illegal and purposeful and malicious forcibly administered overdoses of medically unnecessary drugs as unjust punishment because the said victims, et al., declined to pretend to sleep 18 to 20 hours per day, which torture they had been suffering for over a year and that such cruelty and such atrocity as electro-shock, lobotomy, etc. are used as punishments and political experiences at the arbitrary whim of some incompetent state employee or a means to hush a citizen who has discovered some politician's secret and this is only a small part of the crime and corruption I have witnessed. I, N K Fields, declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed at Santa Cruz, California, 7 February 1968. N K Fields

There is a standing threat in state "hospitals" that anyone seeking a Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus will be punished (Vi 6620, et al notwithstanding). I was warned numerous times, "Write a Writ and the consequences will be horrible. Agonizing drugs, electro-shock and brain surgery are used as punishments in state "hospitals".

The sub-human, drooling examples of the doctor's handiwork were a constant reminder of the threat of lobotomy. Even though I am crippled from torture, it is a miracle that I survived because I retained the moral courage to keep fighting for honor and our Americanism. Even in the face of a threat much worse than death, I gave my promise to quit writing to the courts only twice. Possibly what saved me was that I always had a court action pending and quite possibly the authorities were reluctant to "leave any marks" if I could be suddenly called into court. This was admitted when the quack Doctor Plagens said, "When you are all through writing writs, we'll really go to work on you!"

I witnessed Benjamin Durazo being drugged to death. It took two

Many things have been happening since our last edition, three of which I will touch on here.

Cal Poly's Newman Center said goodbye to Fr. Moore, and is now trying to continue the programs started under his guidance. The people there have been hampered tremendously by the Mission leaders who now control the center. It is heartening to see the students who comprise the majority of the parishoners trying so nobly to continue on the face of such subtle opposition.

The most obvious directive against those who are served by the Newman Center is the limitation of masses to one on Sunday. The direct effect has been to force the daily masses "underground". That is, instead of holding mass, sessions are being held on various aspects of Catholicism.

Such things as Bible studies now are being held to meet the needs of the students. This is, at best, a second-rate replacement for the programs of the past.

A sign of the ineptitude of the Mission's control of the Newman Center is the drop in attendance at the Sunday Mass. When the attendance drops to $\frac{1}{4}$ the size it had been, church officials should get the message. They should replace the dead programs of "Churchianity" with vital, appealing programs which, combined with an inspirational leader, can combine to once again bring in 800 people for a mass. If the church officials can't bring themselves to make the "sacrifices" necessary to reach 3, 4, or 5 times as many people as they now are, perhaps they should look for someone who can... Fr. Moore where are you? Cur best to you!

By the time you read this, Cal Poly will have had its greatest happening. Pres. Robert E. Kennedy will have been inaugurated as king president of Cal Poly.

No one can deny that Cal Poly is growing in size, is offering a larger

variety of courses, is attracting more instructors with higher degrees, or is modernizing its administrative point of view.

But to lay these all at Pres. Kennedy's feet as accomplishments is ridiculous. These advances are nothing more than normal changes which must take place within an institution if it is to survive. They are not, as the T-T editorial of All Fool's Day 1968 implies, a chosen road to follow. Pres. Kennedy must follow such a road to try and bring Cal Poly up to the level of expectation for a California State College. Even though Cal Poly is, as the T-T points out, one of the oldest of the State Colleges, it has the reputation of being way behind other State Colleges in the very important area of academic freedom and student involvement.

It would be a clear indication of Dr. Kennedy's intent for Cal Poly to come up to University level if he made an effort to not only hire, but also retain professors of high quality representing all points of view, politically as well as academically.

But this is not the case. It is quite obvious that the only politically active professors who are safe to express themselves are tenured and conservative faculty members. It is well known that political liberals and radicals are not welcome at Cal Poly, Especially as Faculty Members.

Perhaps Pres. Kennedy isn't aware that the students receive most of their education outside of the classroom. Discussion of controversial issues and acting upon one's convictions goes a long way towards rounding out a student's education.

Put what happens to professors who encourage students in this vein? Ask Mr. De Vries! Ask Dr. Catalina! Ask any student who is really aware of what happens at Cal Poly...

We know what happens to instructors who dare to speak out when Pres Kennedy's administration

doesn't agree! They get canned!!

But just look at the El Mus-tang's inaugural edition. Specifically read the article "Kennedy-builds for the future". Not once does he comment upon the pertinent issues of student activities nor

WHAT IS THE LAW?

MYTHS ABOUT THE NARCOTICS LAW AND THEIR ENFORCEMENT

There are a few special items worth mentioning, not to frighten you, but in the hope that with the proper knowledge you will be able to act wisely.

1. It is not true that you will be prosecuted in the Federal courts if arrested by a Federal Agent, unless you are involved in smuggling or crossing state lines.
2. It is not true that if a police officer says he is not an officer that he cannot arrest you or testify against you. He can swear on a Bible and sign an affidavit that he is not a police officer, and it will make no difference.
3. It is not true that you are not guilty if the narcotics are not yours and you are just holding them for a friend. Ownership is irrelevant.
4. It is not true that just because you have clean record and a good background that you are sure to get probation.

One final word: If you don't like the law, work to change it, don't violate it! The age of martyrs ended several centuries ago that scene is no longer cool.

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"What is the Law" is a column which was originally suggested by many people to make everyone fully aware of the drastic consequences of violation. To this end the staff of this Press enthusiastically publish this column. We urge any person who has a question pertaining to the laws of this community to send it to: El Valley Press, P.O. 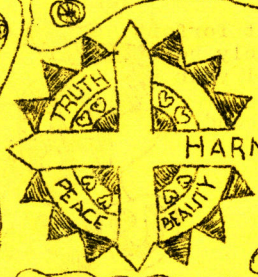

Consider the sharp, physical and mental pleasures of the young and extremely sensitive lovers, Romeo and Juliet, living on a high level of creativity. Now consider, if you will, two very average people--high school graduates or high school drop-outs...They get married in a flash for a little sex...live in a basement to save money...soon get tired of sex, get lonely...bored... They have to yell and scream at each other for a little excitement. Anger is a thrill, so is violence. So they give way to both to keep from being bored. Lust is another thrill. But since they have grown to dislike each other they must separate and search along the dark streets and fetid taverns for whatever madness they can find.

How much good can come from a Nation filled with these types of people who prefer to live in a basement only because they can not imagine the thrills and long lasting pleasures they can find in the rooms up stairs? What must inevitably follow when a Nation continues to live in the gutter feeding only the baser emotions--starving the finer intellect--killing the nobler portion of men?

The happiest men I know are those who, after a hard day's work at some creative job can sit back and say: "I did a good day's work--a little more than I had planned...and a lot better." Truthfully now: doesn't this beat getting all your kicks out of violence, rebellion, lust, madness, murder, dope, etc.? You must admit these pleasure though high are short-lived...and they leave such a bad taste in your mouth! And the memories in later life are never too pleasant.

months to kill him. I was instrumental in keeping Harold Satcher alive day after day while being killed with willful overdoses of cruel drugs. I was suddenly moved off the ward and upon leaving I asked Technician Weidner, "Who's gonna take care of Satcher?" The arrogant answer was "----Satcher!" Satcher died that night.

This Doctor H. A. Nevel is so cruel and cunning that even the other insane doctors detest him. Nevel has a clever means to force inmates to do his bidding. It is a cruel punishment that leaves no marks (on the outside); yet it is quite effective. An inmate must pretend to sleep 18 to 20 hours per day. After several weeks, men feel like jumping up and screaming. If they do, they receive overdoses of drugs. I suffered this sleep punishment for a year. The ordeal has caused damage to my back, my heart and my nervous system. When I was first drugged, I couldn't sleep at all for 5 weeks. For a long time after that I was to sleep from 1/2 to 1 hour. For the rest of the year I didn't average over 3 hours in 24. Even now my ability to sleep is damaged and I don't rest well. One was required to lie absolutely still even though he was being harassed to make him move or open his eyes. This nerve wracking stress and boredom was a more cruel punishment than you could ever imagine.

These kinds of cruelty leave marks inside a man. The object of the quack doctor is not to cure insanity; but to force inmates to praise him and his sleep "program". He was such a detestable swine that it required considerable force to elicit praise. After an inmate couldn't stand any more sleep punishment and decided to praise the doctor, and paid money, he could become a "Red dot". It cost from 2 cartons of cigarets to \$40 to become a Red Dot. The Red Dots are in charge of the "Non-Red Dots" (sounds insane, doesn't it? Well, it is insane). Red Dots are given the power to initiate treatment and drug and, of course, privileges and punishments. They may extort money, they may have sadistic and sex privileges with Non-Red Dots. They even sit in judgement of the sanity of fellow inmates; yet it is much more sinister than this which I will reveal shortly.
