I thank Mr. Humberto Garcia for giving me the opportunity and pleasure of writing for EL EXCENTRICO. Most of all, I would like to thank Mr. Andrew Diaz for recommending me to Mr. Garcia as his successor.

As I begin this column I am reminded of the many misgivings I had even before I definitely decided to do it. However, my misgivings were doubled by some people who told me to forget about the whole thing, because it would bring me a lot of problems; it would be a waste of time; it would bring me a lot of enemies; and because there was no gain in it.

Yes, it will bring me problems. The problem will be to find a topic and the difficulty in writing about it. Mr. Diaz was wrong, I am not a writer, at best I am a scribbler; nevertheless I hope to do justice to the topic I choose to write.

How can I waste my time doing something like this if in doing it I gain some self-knowledge? No, it will not be a waste of time. Writing these articles will force me to think about, and question, our national traditions, both Mexican and American.

This does not mean that I will write only on these subjects or on them at all.

These traditions are like the outline of a painting; we are asked to add the colors and most of us leave them as they are, thinking perhaps that these outlines constitute the painting.

Unfortunately not all have received traditions or values to go by. So part of my self-knowledge will come from questioning the traditions that I was too eager to accept; those that were accepted after some deliberation, and those that were never accepted. I was fortunate, I was not thrown into the world, without anything to go by.

If these articles bring me enemies,

that is fine as long as they do not bring me the wrong kind of friends. By the wrong kind of friends, I mean the flatterers who do not find anything wrong with my writing or with my ideas.

I have felt no sting in being a Mexican; only in being a human being. In this I am sure everyone is alike. For somehow, by nature, or by God, we are asked, rather, we are ordered to live. It is up to us to interpret that order.

By living I do not mean mere existence or the discharge of routines. I mean a life that is aware of itself, of the totality of pain and pleasure. A life that does not lick its wounds will not let them become infected—with hate. Therefore, I will not give you targets to hate; because they will merely make you lick your wounds. I want you to cure your wounds. I am not a doctor, there are no pills here, there is merely a voice.

Not all the articles (if I am still writing the second one) will be serious. Life is too full of ridiculous moments to be serious about us, so why should we be serious about her? I have such a good sense of the ridiculous that my laughter has stopped me from committing so called sins. For as soon as I am about to tell a big lie my inner laughter, not an angel at all, begins. So I tell the truth and soon another kind of laughter begins. Could it be the devil laughing? And at Me!
