On behalf of the students, faculty, and staff I should like to welcome you to Pioneer Stadium and express our appreciation for your participation in College events. The Cal State athletic program is helping to make the College a more integral part of the community.



BOB RODRIGO — Head Coach

The 1971 football campaign will feature a totally new look beginning right at the top with newly appointed head coach Bob Rodrigo.

Coach Rodrigo is highly regarded in California as one of the top offensive coaches on the coast, having had many successful years as an offensive coordinator for San Francisco State College and Cal State College, Hayward.

During his stint here at Cal State, the Pioneers offensive team continually improved, and was one of the highest scoring outfits in the country during the 1969 and 1970 seasons.

While attending San Francisco State College, Rodrigo was named to the NCAA College All-American team in 1954-56-57 as a fullback. He is still regarded as one of the top players to ever play in the Far Western Conference, having been named to the All-Far Western Conference team in 1954-55-56-57, and as an All-Pacific Coast selection for four consecutive years.

Before joining the Pioneer staff, Rodrigo was the offensive coordinator for the Gators of San Francisco State. He held that position for eleven years before joining the Hayward staff in 1968.

A 1958 graduate of San Francisco State, Rodrigo went on to receive his master's degree in physical education from the same institution. As a member of the Department of Physical Education at Cal State, Hayward, coach Rodrigo also serves as the head golf coach during the Spring.

DON SAWYER — Offensive Line Coach

Sawyer enjoyed one of the most illustrious careers as a lineman of any player in the East Bay during his prep and college seasons.

A two year letterman at Castro Valley High School, coach Sawyer went to Chabot Junior College and was named to the Golden League Conference All-Star team for two consecutive years in 1966 and 1967.

While a starter for the Pioneers at Cal State, Hayward, Sawyer was named the most valuable lineman in 1967, and was an All Far Western Conference selection during that season.

Coach Sawyer signed as a free agent with the Oakland Raiders in 1968 and was regarded as one of the best linemen to ever come out of the Northern California Bay Area.

TOM MEEKINS — Line Coach

Meekins, a standout football player at Lincoln High School, was named to the All-Conference Eastern League in San Diego in 1961. While attending Lincoln, coach Meekins was an All-Conference selection in wrestling, and was the 1961 Southern Section C.I.F. runner-up in wrestling as a heavyweight.

Coach Meekins attended Cal Western University in San Diego, and was named to the NAIA Western team in football during the 1963 and 1964 seasons as a linebacker. Upon his graduation from Cal Western in 1965, he signed a pro contract with the San Diego Chargers and played one year in the AFL as a defensive back during the 1965 season.

DON CHU — Offensive End Coach

Chu was a former prep quarterback at Edison High School in Fresno during the 1958-59 seasons, before entering the service.


After returning from his service duty, Chu played football for the Fresno City College Rams in 1964 as a defensive back. That year, the Fresno club had one of its most successful years in the valley, winning the Valley Conference Football championship in 1964.

During the 1965 and 1966 seasons, Chu played at the defensive back position for the Pioneers here at Cal State, and led the Pioneers in interceptions during the 1965 season with seven steals.

TIM TIERNEY — Defensive Coordinator

A 1964 graduate of San Francisco State College, Tierney was an All-Far Western Conference defensive back in 1963 and again in 1964. After graduation he was highly sought after by the Philadelphia Eagles, and he played in the Eagles organization for two years from 1965 to 1966. After two years as a defensive back in the pro ranks, Tierney returned to San Francisco State to begin his coaching career working with defensive backs.



PIONEERS ON THE GO!



PIONEERS VERSUS THE AGGIES

The Cal State Hayward Pioneers, current leaders of the Far Western Conference, play host to the U.C. Davis Aggies today at 1:30 p.m. Cal State carries an overall 6-0-1 and 3-0-1 Far Western Conference record into the game, while Davis stands 6-1-0 and 3-1-0.

Offensively, the Pioneers are led by freshman quarterback Mike Jacinto, who engineered last week's amazing comeback victory over Humboldt State. Fleet flanker Wes Jackson, who does his ceremonial victory dance after each touchdown pass, is having a great year. Halfback Bert Castelanelli, fullback John Shew, and offensive linemen Monty Consani, Curtis Thomas, and Scott Yeaman bolster the Pioneer offense.

Defensively, the Pioneers are led by defensive tackle Clinton "Sundown Brown," safety John Yavasile, linebacker Gary Feletar, et al. The tenacious Pioneer defense is the key to this year's success.

The U.C. Davis Aggies boast an outstanding quarterback in Ron Van De Pol, who has completed 61 percent of his passes this season. Tight end Mike Bellotti and running backs Jim Campbell and Carey Laine compliment the potent Aggie offense. Defensively, the Aggies are led by Jim Fiack, Bob Weinger, and Bruce Groefsema.

Besides being the annual homecoming game, today's battle will probably determine the eventual winner of the Far Western Conference football championship. U.C. Davis, Cal State Hayward, and Chico State College are all in a heated battle for this honor.

PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES AT CAL STATE

California State College, Hayward is one of the 19 institutions comprising the California State Colleges, the largest and most diverse system of public higher education in the Western Hemisphere. Located in the hills of Hayward (population 94,000) on the east shore of San Francisco Bay, the College is a young and expanding campus serving the varied educational needs of the large urban complex in which it is located.
