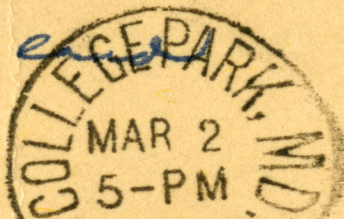
March! -

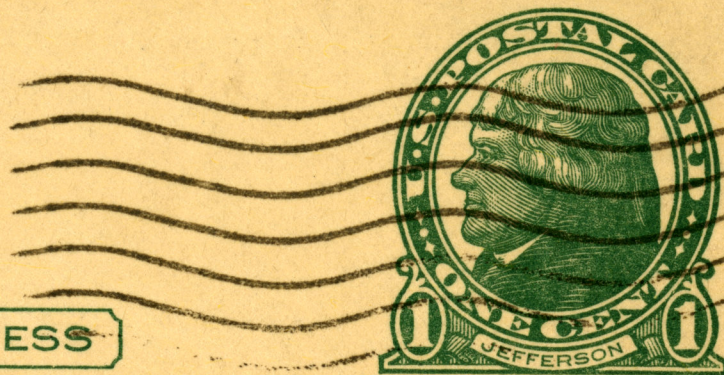
Sid Lorraine & Wilda drop in to see you? They were planning to.
