captain Barrett then reported that he had temporarily suspended work on the Santa Margarita Rancho under the instructions of the Board, and the Attorneys of the Company having reported to the Board that they had been unable to come to any satisfactory arrangement with the holders of the Mortgage on the land, on motion duly made and seconded, it was resolved that the Manager be, and he is hereby instructed to remove from the Santa Margarita Ranch all machinery of this Company now thereon and to suspend any further work on said property until the further orders of this Board.
