## Remodel of the Bulldog Study Office

Last year, the Peters Building offered minimal quiet study space in common areas. The main study space offered was in the Bulldog Study Corner which was purposed for conference style meetings.

With this renovation, we were able to add 2 high-top tables seating **12**, and **10** additional bench seats with shared desk space which allow more students to enjoy a more private study facility.

Importantly, these spaces also accommodate for those with physical disabilities.

## 85 New Study Spaces at the Craig School!

Through a generous private donation from a Craig School of Business alumnus, Larry Clemmensen, the college was able to install new furniture and building upgrades for student use.

After planning for many months, the new upgrades were unveiled the first day of Spring Semester 2018.

The new space includes **70** comfortable seats for study breaks between classes.

We also designed **15** collaboration zones for student team meetings and for group projects.
