T<mark>he present consolidated, county-wide court was cr</mark>eated by the Legislature in 1965 and is unique in California. Within this structure we have concentrated our judges in the population centers while continuing to hold daily sessions in outlying communities. A new department of our court will open in the Simi Valley this year.

We have been able to increase the volume of our work by over one-half without requiring additional judges. We have eliminated backlogs of old cases awaiting trial throughout the county.

I am one of the seven original judges of this court, and now serve as its presiding judge.
