Dear Senator Lagomarsino:

You say that you got most of the "local bills" passed. However, you voted against the Governor's budget and in so doing cut out essential appropriations for Camarillo State Hospital (Services for the Children's Unit was one). The cuts also hamper the progress of the whole state Mental Health program. The net result will increase state hospitalization and increase the cost of mental illness in the state.

This budget cutting sounds more like Republican political maneuvers than real economy.

As you return to Sacramento next week to reconsider the Governor's proposed budget, I hope you will represent the majority in our county (the majority re-elected Governor Brown on his clearly outlined platform with nearly 38,000 votes in our county in 1962) and not be swayed by the views of the minority (the minority elected you with less than 14,000 votes in our county in the 1961 Special Election).
