The most important issue that we have to address tonight is that we need an Airport Director who will listen to the community and not just try to expand the use of the Airport. The City and County had agreed years ago to have an Airport that was compatible with the community, not try to make the community compatible with regional airport needs. We do not care what FAA wants and what the regional needs are. We want a Director who will respond to our wishes to have an Airport that does not harm our community. The present Director has demonstrated time after time that he believes the City should be compatible with what he views as the regional airport needs

Let us urge the Board of Supervisors to drop the Draft Revised Oxnard Airport Master Plan, EA/EIR Noise Study, and find a Director who will make the Airport compatible with the community. We are tired of these games.
