After transference of evacuees from the Assembly Centers to Relocation Centers, each Assembly Center facility was quickly transferred by the Wartime Civil Control Administration, as an agency of the Western Defense Command, to various Military agencies. The Centers, without exception, were being utilized by the new military using agency in a remarkably short time after the exodus of evacuees.

The final date of evacuee occupancy - The date of transfer to the Military using agency and - The name of the Military user are disclosed in the following table.
