Here is a fact sheet on the Lynch Delegation to the Democratic National Convention:

The 172-man slate (plus National Committeeman and Woman and plus alternates) is expected to include our Congressional delegation (with few exceptions), representatives from the State Senate and Assembly, party officers, and a broad cross-section of representatives from business and industry, labor, professional groups, ethnics, contributors, women, etc. with a limited number from each group.

The Lynch slate will be pledged to support President Johnson, though his name will not appear on the Ballot. This slate will be placed on the Primary Ballot along with the McCarthy, Peace and Freedom, Wallace and Reagan slates.

A charge of \$200 has been proposed for each delegate, which will help underwrite the cost of this primary campaign. In addition, there will be hotel and travel expenses for each delegate. The Convention will be held in Chicago, August 26 - 29th.

Assemblyman Charles Warren, Chairman of the Selection Committee of the Lynch Delegation has asked me to recommend the names of those women who may be interested in being included as Delegates. If you are interested in having your name submitted, please send me a brief typed list of your qualifications. Mail it to the above address.
