I Hereby Certify, that, in accordance with the provisions of an Act entitled "An Act to provide for the management and sale of the lands belonging to the State," approved March 28th, 1868, and the several Acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, I have located as a portion of the School Lands 320 acres of Public Land in the County of San Luis Obispo at the request and for the use of Mrs. B. Baker Said Land is described as follows:

Dollars, within fifty days from the date of the Surveyor-General's approval, being twenty per cent. of the purchase money, and interest on the balance in advance, at the rate of ten per cent. per annum, from the date of the approval of the location in the Surveyor-General's Office, to the first day of January, 1876; and unless such payment is made within said fifty days, then the above described land shall revert to the State without suit, and this approval be and become null and void.
