## *The Aeolian Company's Tribute to the Memory of Beethoven, the Great Master*

THE Centenary of one of the two greatest musicians the world has ever seen, has been chosen for the occasion to issue in roll form the most important contribution made by any composer to the literature of the piano.

The whole of Beethoven's Thirty-two Pianoforte Sonatas, comprising over one hundred complete movements, will be added to the catalogue of "The World's Music." The work of recording this great series of classics has been entrusted to world-famous pianists, and, stupendous as the task has been, it is nearing completion, some of the rolls being already available. The printed annotations, analyses, and pictures have been contributed by eminent authors and artists under the direction of Percy A. Scholes, the editor of "The World's Music" Series of Illustrated and Descriptive Rolls for the 'Duo-Art' and 'Pianola' Piano.

In the whole history of the Player Piano no work approaching this in importance and magnitude has ever before been attempted. Truly this is a worthy and fitting memorial to the memory of the Master.
