

# Cabrillo Port LNG Deepwater Port Joint EIS/EIR

## Information for Commenters

Thank you for registering to give comments during the public meeting. The following information is provided to let you know what to expect during the meeting. The meeting will begin with brief presentations by lead agency representatives. Commenters will be recognized in the following order:

1. Elected officials.
2. Other public agencies.
3. Individuals or groups in the order of signup on the list of Commenters.
4. Others who wish to speak, if time permits.

**To allow the greatest number of speakers possible, the following meeting procedures will be used:**

- The meeting facilitator will call out names of commenters in groups of 5 to 10 and ask them to wait in seating near the podium.
- Commenters should identify themselves by name and affiliation, if applicable.
- A court reporter is recording a transcript of the meeting and the comments.
- One person will speak at a time so the court reporter will be able to record each person's comments.
- Comments do not need to be given orally at more than one public meeting.
- Written and oral comments will be given the same consideration.
- Each commenter may speak for up to 3 minutes.
- Speaking times may not be combined.
- Comments that are most useful at this time are those that identify key environmental concerns related to the project that are not covered in the Notice of Intent/Notice of Preparation, including alternatives, methodologies, or mitigation.

**No action will be taken until the environmental review process is completed.**
