We are very busy down here in Los Angeles with our Pat Brown Testimonial Dinner on May 31 and the Brown primary election campaign. It is unfortunate that the State Committee is receiving very little help from any other Democratic organization for either of these events, expecially inasmuch as the Brown campaign is supposed to be financed totally from the Dinner.
