It could be used for a living room or sleeping room.

This story would be above the ground and perfectly healthy.

It would be even very attractive as the loggia would be a fine feature both for use and beauty.

The loggia would also I think greatly relieve the architectural bareness of these lower areas of wall.

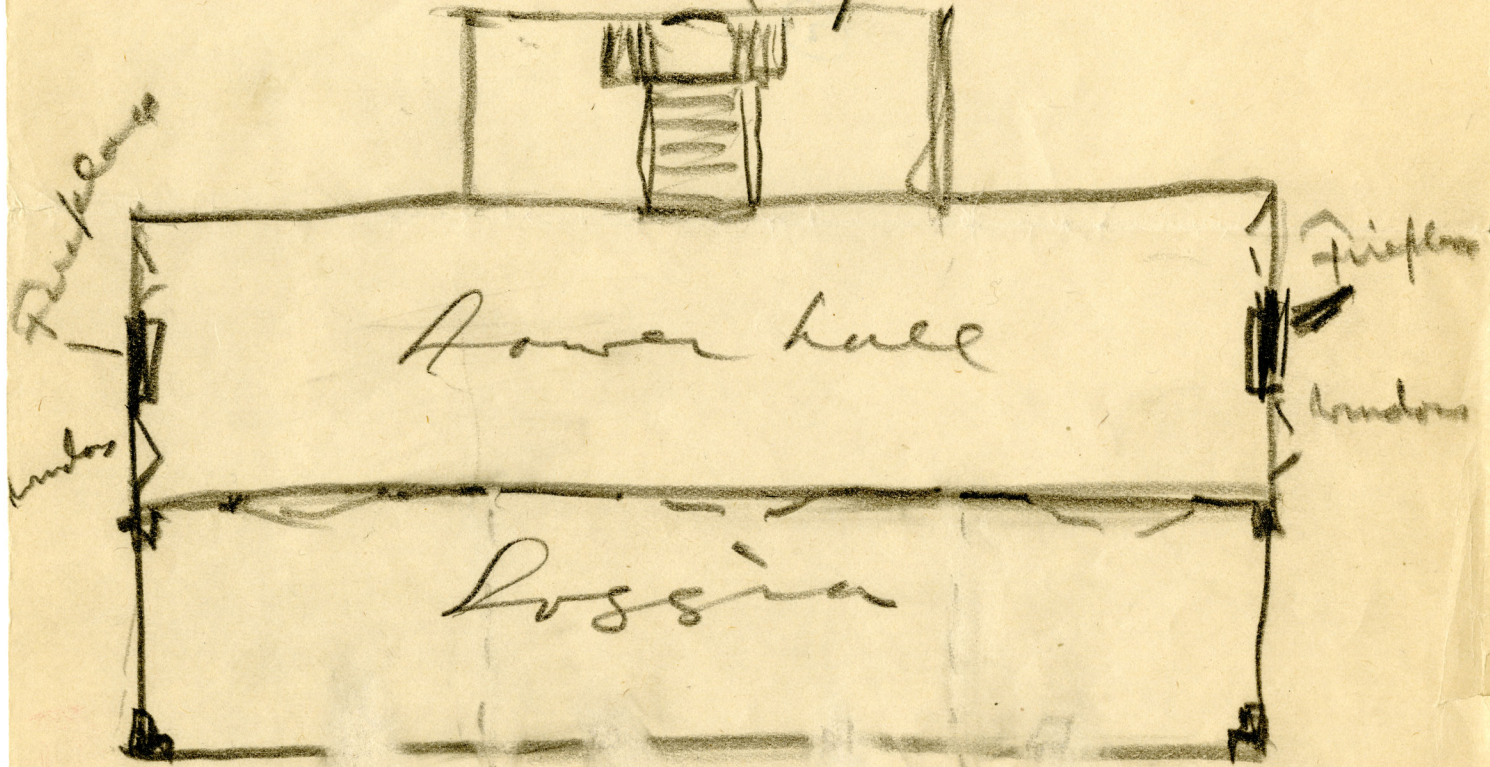
Anyhow the space is there. Why not use it. It can be made valuable.
