Philosophy. To share with the people of Ventura County the latest developments in psychology, the thirty-one members of the Ventura County Psychological Association, in cooperation with the civic leaders of the community, will offer a Psychology Fair for and with the people. Admission free !

Target. On a Saturday, in mid January of 1974, at one of the Community Centers, psychologists will present the latest developments in the study of human behavior. In addition to lectures, they will present live demonstrations of new techniques in both group and individual counseling.

Offices will also be manned at the Center by the psychologists during the Fair for those who wish to seek information privately.

Funds will be raised by patron support of a brochure/program. These funds will pay: the salary of a professional public information person; the Center janitorial service; cartage of equipment; costs of invitations to national, state and other community leaders.

Excess funds can be given to the support of the County Free Clinics.
