WELCOME TO CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD'S FIRST SUMMER SESSION!!

Registration is never an enjoyable process for anyone. With the weather turning hot and lots of people running around, and lines forming, it makes matters worse. Thus, please read the directions carefully and avoid any unnecessary efforts.

The first step is to go directly to the first class you wish to take. If the class carries (15-19 students are needed in most classes), the instructor will provide you with registration material and a set of instructions (See Registration Instructions below). With materials completed you will go to LB 100 for verification and key punching; and then to the Cashier's Office for fee payment.

If the class folds, drop by the Library or Cafeteria for a break and decide which other class may be suitable for your needs!

Should you have any questions regarding the Summer Program, come by the table in LB 100 or the Summer Session Office in Adm. 109.

SUMMER SESSION REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

1. If you are registering for two classes, please wait until after the second class convenes to complete registration, as that class may not continue.
2. If you are registering for three classes, please obtain an "Excess Program Permit" from the Director of Summer Sessions and present at verification table in Lecture Building 100. Although registration for three classes is permitted, state regulations provide that the maximum for which you may receive credit in a six weeks summer session is 10 quarter units.
3. You will be given by your instructor:

A. Class card	D. Parking permit application
B. Receipt card	E. Registration form
C. Ethnic survey card	

4. A. Do not write anything on the class card.
B. Fill in name, social security number, and class level on the receipt card.
C. Fill in completely the ethnic survey card.
D. Fill in completely the parking permit application.
E. Fill in completely the registration form.
5. Proceed to Lecture Building Room 100 to verification table to have forms checked for accuracy.*
6. Proceed to Key Punch operators where you will be given a fee card for each class card you present.
7. Proceed to Administration Building for determination and payment of fees.

Fees are \$16.00 per quarter unit. Parking fees are \$5.00 for the six weeks session and \$3.00 for the three weeks session. (A 25¢ metered parking lot is available as an alternative.) Citations will be issued to students and faculty with no parking sticker on their automobile.

* Credential advisement and applications for fall student teaching will be available in Lecture Building Room 100 during the day.
