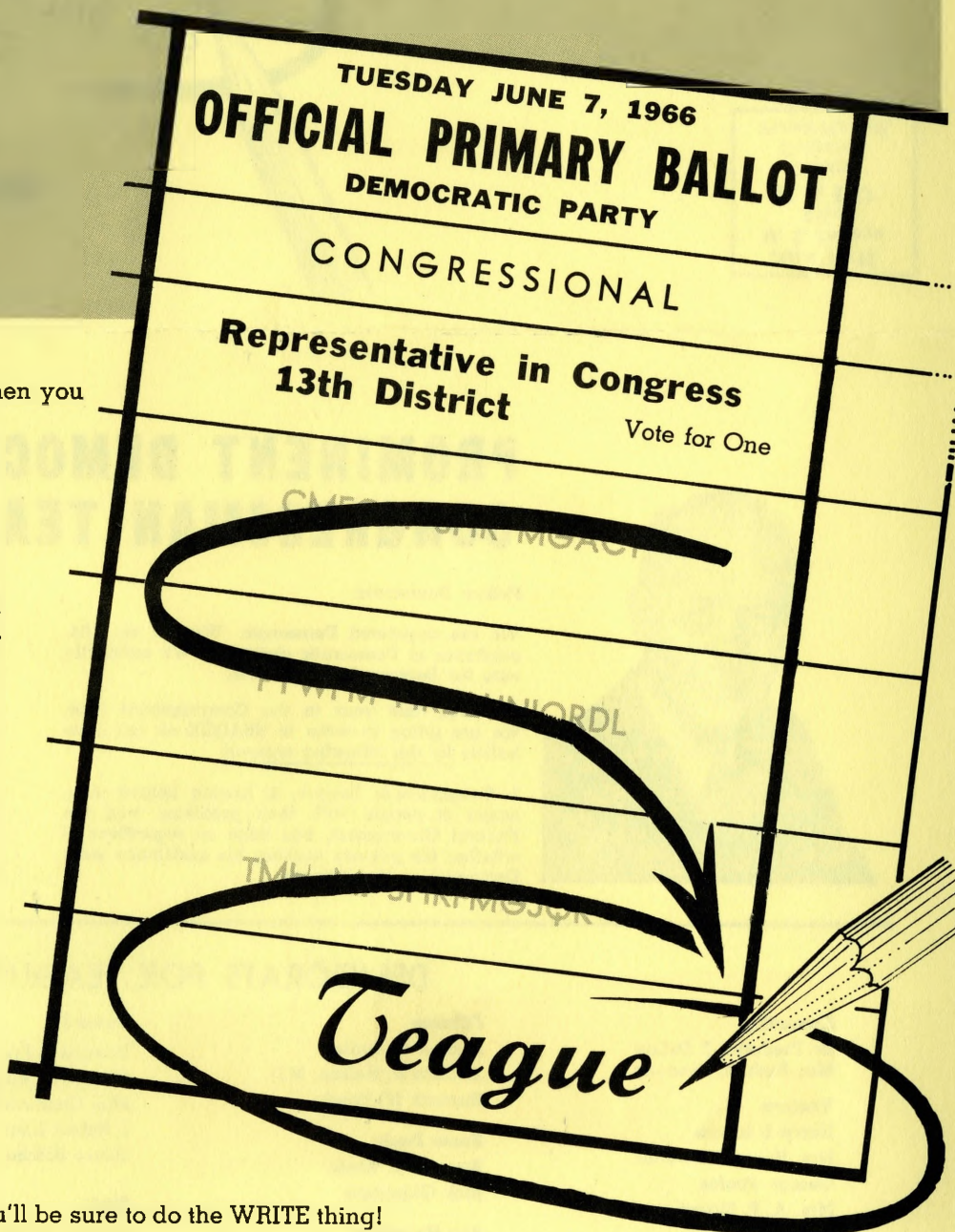
**HERE'S HOW:**
