

family name at the Fresno Center. Katonabe the Japanese counterpart for the American name of "Smith" was down the list with only 10. "Tanaka" "Nakagawa" and "Sasaki" were tied for 2nd most popular name with each name represented by fourteen families. Taniguchi, Yamada and Nakamura followed in that order.

Youngsters like Marubayashi and Machigashira contrasted with names like Ono, and Nii.

> Families were defined at the Assembly Center as all the persons registering for evacuation on a single "Social Data Registration Form."

Family sizes at Fresno ranged from ~~more than~~ ^{about} 600 single individuals to two families with 13 members.

From May 6 thru October 30, 1942 the Center housed a total of 1294 families with a mean ^{and median} average ^{size} of 4.0 persons per family, and a total occupancy of 5,229 individuals.
