All dispatchers are certified through the State of California "Police Officer Standards Training" (POST) and receive continuous "in service" training." We answer both emergency and non-emergency calls and can dispatch:

- Police
- Fire
- Ambulance
- Tow Services
- Cal-trans, County Roads Services (For Lewis and Protrero roads)
- other non-emergency agencies in Ventura County i.e. Animal control, Child Protective Services, SCE, Gas Company, etc.
