- 245 students received the Provost Graduation Initiative sponsorship to graduate in the Summer and/or Fall 2016.
- Provost Graduation Initiative helped increase the graduation rate between 2015-2018.
- 874 total units were sponsored by this initiative in 2016.
- 2016-2018 FTFTF graduation rate increased by a total of 5.8%.
