Yesterday I mailed you extracts

2/ Am afraid the drip from the  
lathed courts would ruin the pavements. Would not  
hot frames like for the Bouganvillias, set up in  
front of the more delicate plants, answer the pur-  
pose?

3. The edges of the shades now up  
are frayed already. I will order some better shade  
cloth and have it painted as you suggest, and put up  
with wire guards.

The roof was on "A" before the storm  
came, although the tile was not on. No damage was  
done.
