His division included Health and Hospitals, Education programs and facilities, Recreation, Religious activities, Center Store, Nursery Schools, Entertainment Programs, Center Meeting Facilities, Visitors Center, Clothing Allotment Program, Library, Center Publications, Outdoor Theater, Forums and Seminars, Social Welfare, Music, Special events, Information and Special Issues for Indigents.

Carl Bengston served as Recreation Director. He was the youngest member of the administrative staff. Tall and blue eyed with fair skin and wavy golden blonde hair, he was born in Kingsburg, California, only a few miles from the center. With his soft, low voice and broad smile, he provided the motive power behind an all-encompassing recreation program.
