Inter-Company softball starts Monday, "A" vs. "B".

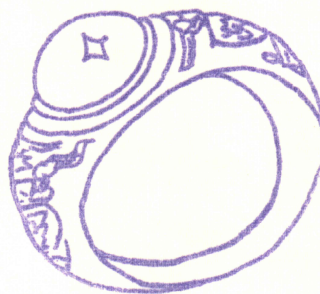

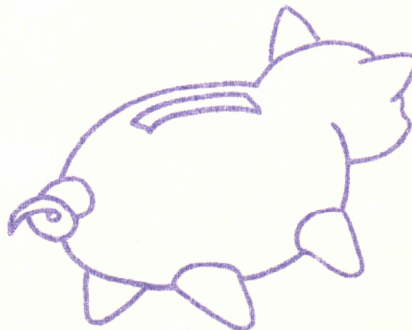
