

1. Getting Oxnard's share of taxes paid to other agencies. A separate Flood Zone for the Oxnard Plain would guarantee for years ahead that the hundreds of thousands of tax dollars paid yearly by Oxnarders would be spent to benefit the people of Oxnard. An Oxnard College campus would be an important employer as well as provide the opportunity for a larger percentage of Oxnarders to pursue higher education. County and State park funds spent on a regional park in Oxnard would bring facilities to the center of the population. Use of the total resources of the city staff, the City Council, and the whole community working together for these goals also unites business, industry and the people of Oxnard.
2. I favor either a "thru route" that would guide traffic down to 6th street for a part of the route or a Washington D.C. style circle. All over Washington, D.C. very heavy traffic comes ~~together~~ together at intersections formed into circles. Traffic is eased around these circles without traffic lights and without the congestion and delays we have at the Plaza. This would allow traffic to continue on 5th street.
3. It would be hard to say for this year without examining the costs in relation to alternatives and sources of revenue. It should surely be within the five year plan. It may take working cooperatively with other agencies to accomplish.
4. The county airport in Oxnard should not be allowed to expand its operation. Every measure should be taken to decrease the dangers and nuisance of the airport to the people of Oxnard. The OAFB would best serve the people of the County with ~~an~~ educational and recreational use. Possibly some industrial use would be valuable if that were within the plan of Camarillo.
5. The city council should explore the possibility developing a workable plan for rehabilitation. It would be worthwhile spending ~~an amount~~ a reasonable amount more than a new structure would cost. Oxnard badly needs to keep a structure of historic significance in the city. If we destroy our past, we lose in our search for identity.

6. I would prefer Oxnard's future cultural center to be located east of the Community Center to tie into the downtown. In order to ^{re-}build a significant central business district and convention center, there needs to be facilities pulling these two centers together.
7. There have been important changes in the city administration during the past year (Housing Authority and Redevelopment Agency brought within the city administration). More time is needed to derive full benefit from these changes. I would not suggest further changes at this time.
