French film writer-director Lorraine Levy created this film based on a story of two young men — one Israeli, the other Palestinian — who were accidently switched at birth and raised on the "wrong side of the struggle." Their lives are shattered by this revelation as they and their families are forced to reconsider identity, values and beliefs.
