Commissioner Rogalsky reported on Women's History Project Awards (date March 27). The National theme is "Discover a New World: Women's History materials are in. Commissioner Weingardt will work with Commissioner Rogalsky to get the flyer out. A question of publicity: it was recommended that the Committee work with Catherine Swanson of the Women's Center at CLU. The Committee still needs to discuss how to spread awards throughout the County.

Commissioner Weingardt announced that GTE has contacted us about our being eligible for a free yellow page ad. Commissioner Weingardt moved and Commissioner Lawrason seconded that we pursue this and take advantage of whatever they will offer. Motion passed.

The Commission agreed that we send out a press release on the change in the chair position for the Commission and highlight the Women's History Awards and other projects. Commissioner Rogalsky will assist Commissioner Weingardt with the press release.

Commissioner Harrion expressed for herself, and for the Commission, gratitude for the leadership Commissioner Breyman has shown and for contributions she has made.
