Governor Edmund G. Brown today appointed Louis A. Baptista, a Hollywood banker, to the Board of Trustees of Camarillo State Hospital.

He reappointed Mrs. Jane Tolmach of Oxnard.

"Mr. Baptista has served for nearly a year as a trustee of Metropolitan State Hospital and has proved his deep concern for and good judgment about the problems of the mentally ill," the governor said. "I am, in effect, transferring him to the Camarillo trustees to fill the vacancy created by the death of George Grimes of Camarillo."

"Mrs. Tolmach has given devoted and effective service to the board and deserves reappointment," he said.

The appointments require Senate confirmation.

Baptista, a native of Portugal, was educated in Portugal and in Boston where he began his banking career. He is an officer of United California Bank. His home is in Studio City.

Mrs. Tolmach is a graduate of Smith College and U.C.L.A. She formerly was a social worker with the American Red Cross Field Service.
