Dripping sweat and bar water, "4-Way," also known as Jeff, lead singer for Bad Posture, belts out songs about day-to-day life.

I had the chance to catch Bad Posture at the last Punk Globe party at the On Broadway, and to speak with 4-Way.

He says, "We don't like to sing about Reagan or politics because the majority of the people who come to see us know about that stuff. Most just want to come to listen to the music and have a good time. It's the day-to-day things, like taking too many drugs or drinking too much, that really affects their lives. Our song, "Time For Smack," isn't anti-drugs; it's about when the junk starts using you."

Another topic that inspires 4-Way is the nuclear threat situation. But Bad Posture doesn't preach to the thrashers about trying to stop the big companies from building bombs themselves.

"In our no-nuclear song, we just say, if it happens, it happens," says 4-Way. "But if it does happen, we just hope they've gotten to do everything they wanted to do."

4-Way's antics the night of the Punk Globe party included sliding across the water-drenched stage and slamming into lead guitarist Steve. Then, while being electrocuted by his microphone, Steve and Eddie led the melodies and Emillio held down the bottom on bass, adding a bit of sadistic humor to the performance.

Right now Bad Posture is in search of a permanent drummer for the band. As it is, says 4-Way, "If we perform and one of our three drummers doesn't show up, we usually can find someone in the audience who knows the rhythms and can fill-in.."

The band recently wrapped up a recording session produced by Dead Kennedys bass player, Klaus Flouride: 4-Way claims that the group recorded 45-minutes worth of songs in two hours.

"We recorded on a 4-track system, doing each song in one take."

When I asked when we could expect release of the lp, 4-Way wasn't sure, but noted that it would not be a record release. "We're gonna put it out on cassette as most of the kids we know own a cassette player. And usually, if they have a stereo, they have a cassette player to boot."

And how did Bad Posture come about? "We played our first gig last New Years Eve," says 4-Way. "We did it as a joke. We'd only rehearsed once, the day before the show. I wrote all the lyrics the night of the show, and til this day, we still use them. The crowd liked us, so we decided, why not?"

At present, Bad Posture is working on a new set they hope to use by the end of the summer. Some of their old tunes may be incorporated.

When asked to describe his group, 4-Way says, "We're anti-anti. We don't like to tell people to do something. People spend too much time being against everything."



When asked to describe Fang in one word their lead singer Slammie replied "Garage". After hearing Fang for awhile you hear that the music is nt your basic 1234 thrash. My best description would be a good mixture of the 60's Psychedlic sound with todays hardcore. Althou Fang has been a band for nearly 2 years, this format of the band has been together for 7 months. Tom their guitar player is the only original member. The following inter-view was done before the Punk Globe party at The On Broadway.

P.G.; Could you give us your name and what you do with the band.

Fang; Slammie=Lead Singer, Tom Flynn=Guitar, Joel Fox=Drums, Chris Wilson =Bass Guitar, and me Boy Fang=Roadie

Slammie = We all knew Tom and he was looking for people so we got together. Chris joined the group last September, Me and Joel staerted in March of 82.

JOEL- I'd played with a few other bands here in the area before joining Fang. For six months I played with Sic Pleasure, and before that I played with Subsidized Mess whom latter became Crucifix.

P.G.:=Who writes the lyrics and music?

Slammie=I write the lyrics and the band writes the music.

P.G.=Who are your influences?

Slammie=Jimi Hendrix, My Mom, Ozzy Osbourne, Bootsy, and The Kingston Trio.

Joel=Keith Moon, Billy Cobham, and for punk TSOL.

Slammie=Joel has his own definite style of drumming.

Chris=While everyone was listening to The Stones and The Beatles I liked The Jackson Five, The Supremes, Aretha and all.Right-now I'd have to say Free Beer.

P.G.=How many songs do you have?

Joel =About 14 or 15

Tom = If Nico ever gets off the stage we'll probably do about 12 of them.

Punk Globe=How did you get the name Fang?

<u>Tom=</u> Ihad a cat that I had named Fang, and it died of Luekemia. So this is a dedication to him. A tribute!

Punk Globe=What clubs here in the area have you played?

Slammie=The Elite, On Broadway, and The Berkeley Square. Oh and TheS&M.

Punk Globe=How about recordings?

Tom = We have a cut on the upcoming KPFA Lp. Slammie=We wanna get a 45 out by fall.

Punk Globe= Any tour plans?

Slammie=We'd like to tour the Southwest but right now nothing is set.

Punk Globe=What do you think about the local scene?

Chris=There is'nt enough support given to the local bands. With bands like Free Beer and Code Of Honor who needs bands from L.A. and the U.K.

Slammie=There is 'nt enough places to play either. What happened to The DeafClub, Rats, The Temple? With all the bands in the city we need more places to play. We enjoy playing with about any band that is good so we can expose our music to new people.

Punk Globe=What about politics and music?

Slammie = I don't write my lyrics around politics. I think that the country should be run by a non corrupt Democracy rather than an Anarchy. Ben Franklin said "There needs to be a revoulution every 200 years to get the government straight. "We're 200 years late.


