SABBATICAL AND DIFFERENCE-IN-PAY LEAVES

Applications for 1991-92 Sabbatical and Difference-in-Pay leaves are being accepted at this time and are available in the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. In accordance with CSU regulations, full-time faculty unit employees who have held full-time positions in academic assignments for six consecutive academic years are eligible for any one of the following types of sabbatical leave:

- a) one quarter at full pay
- b) two quarters at 3/4 of full pay
- c) three quarters at 1/2 of full pay

An applicant granted a difference-in-pay leave receives an amount of pay that is the difference between the applicant's salary and the minimum salary at the instructor rank.

Two deadlines have been established for filing Difference-in-Pay applications, and one deadline for Sabbatical Leave applications:

Sabbatical Leave	November 2, 1990
Difference-in-Pay Leave	November 2, 1990 March 1, 1991

Applications must be channeled through respective departmental and deans levels before being submitted to the Faculty Honors and Awards Committee (c/o the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs). Please reference the CSUB Handbook (Section 310), for guidelines, governing sabbatical and difference-in-pay regulations.
